TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- A 'float' is defined as any moving vehicle, display, pedestrian, or group.
- **All procession floats must have public liability insurance and attach a copy with their entry form**
- **All vehicles must be registered (including trailers, horse floats etc.)**
- All floats are to proceed, slow down or stop as directed by any procession official at all times
- Children are to be supervised by an adult at all times while on a float or walking in the procession
- Participants must abide by WHS guidelines
- All floats must be safe and in control of a responsible person. There must be safe driving and behaviour at all times.
- Leave a minimum of six metres between yourself and the float in front of you at all times.
- Leave a gap of twenty metres between you and any livestock (horses etc.) Do not blow horns or sirens and startle the animal.
- Do not throw any sweets or forms of debris or giveaways to the crowd.
- All animals entered in the procession must be insured by the owner. Or they will be unable to participate.

Thank you for participating. The terms and conditions are to help ensure the safety of the spectators and participants.
